Founded in 2007, <u>Tsering's Fund</u> is an organization committed helping underprivileged children and families in Nepal.

Tsering's Fund provides **access** to **education** and **basic necessities** such as food, while also raising awareness of the trafficking crisis in Nepal. According to their site, **approximately 20,000 girls from Nepal are trafficked yearly**.

Given that trafficking is heightened in vulnerable populations, by giving these **young women access to education** they are considered to be of greater value to the family and as such are at a **lessened risk** for being trafficked.

Tsering's Fund focuses on locating at risk girls and placing them in schools. This organization has roots in Bozeman, and we encourage you to check it out!

Pornography is **linked** to sex trafficking as it can involve people who are trafficked for sex. Many people, predominantly **women**, are **forced**, **frauded**, **or coerced** into pornography.

Since it is likely that the average **viewer** does not know for sure whether those involved in a video are there **willingly**, clicking on porn directly fuels the **demand** for sex trafficking. Being aware is an **essential** step in combating human trafficking. While the internet is boundlessly **useful**, even for fighting human trafficking, it is also **undesirably** harmful in ways often not as obvious. <u>This site</u> encourages us to be conscientious of our internet presence and stop the demand.
